

Information on course and exam participation

In addition to vaccination, wearing masks remains the most effective measure in the fight against the Coronavirus as well as other respiratory pathogens. Therefore, where a distance of two meters is not maintained (entrances, assembly areas, etc.), it is recommended to wear a mask (FFP2 or MNS) from the time of entering until leaving the building where the lecture room is located, as well as during the lecture. Wearing a mask is no longer mandatory.

Currently, providing proof of a merely low epidemiological risk for the entry into the course or exam building is no longer checked or required when attending courses or taking exams.

Students who are ill with COVID-19 or with typical COVID-19 symptoms (particularly fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, olfactory and gustatory disturbances, myalgia, unclear, newly appeared skin lesions, non-food-related diarrhoea) or those affected by contact restrictions of persons with a positive SARS-CoV-2 test may not attend courses.

The information in the study guide will be adjusted accordingly.
